

Story Medical Center Endowment Foundation Scholarship

The Story Medical Center Endowment Foundation will be awarding two \$500 scholarships to two local seniors who will graduate this year from either Ballard High School, Collins-Maxwell High School, Colo-Nesco High School, Gilbert High School, Nevada High School or Roland-Story High School. This scholarship has been designed to assist graduating seniors who desire to pursue a post-secondary education in any state-accredited institution which provides training in a health-related field. This scholarship money may be used for any bona fide school expenses such as tuition, fees and books.

A broad-based criteria is used in the selection process. The principal criterion is a demonstrated commitment to post-secondary education in a health-related field. Another key criterion will be service to school and community with special emphasis upon leadership roles in these areas. The Story Medical Center Endowment Foundation is looking not only for students who are willing to serve in the health field, but are also potential leaders in the communities in which they will serve. An applicant's academic record, communication skills, instructor recommendation and need for financial assistance are also considered.

Seniors from either Ballard High School, Collins-Maxwell High School, Colo-Nesco High School, Gilbert High School, Nevada High School or Roland-Story High School who feel they meet the criteria for eligibility and selection are invited to submit applications. A copy of this application may be obtained through the guidance department of any of the above-mentioned high schools and must be postmarked (if submitting by regular mail) no later than **Wedneday, April 13**, or time stamped no later than 5:00pm (if submitting by email) on **Thursday, April 14** for the application and supporting materials to be considered by the scholarship selection committee.
